SOME INFORMATION WHEN BOOKING YOUR WEDDING WITH US

COSTING

The cost of hiring the Museum is €1250.00. A booking deposit of €250.00 is required to secure the booking and this can be paid in person, by direct transfer to our bank account or by credit card over the phone. This fee covers the use of the Museum to set up 1.5 hours before the ceremony and for 2 hours after the ceremony start time.

Should you require extra time to decorate the day beforehand additional charges may apply. If you would like to include any other personal touches for your ceremony such as flowers, music, etc. we would be happy to discuss these with you in person.

PLEASE NOTE THAT THE USE OF CONFETTI IS STRICTLY PROHIBITED.

DETAILS OF WHAT IS INCLUDED IN THE OVERALL COST

- Ornate chairs for the happy couple.
- A red carpet.
- Provision and setting up of chairs for your guests, (NB these are our standard black and chrome chairs). If you wish to hire different chairs we can recommend suppliers for you to contact.
- A table (750mm x 750mm) with white tablecloth to place a floral bouquet, candles, sand, ribbon etc. also to sign the register.
- Microphones available for the Celebrant and any readers that you may have and bluetooth connection to PA system available for downloaded music via phone/tablet etc.
- We cater for weddings with seated guest numbers from 4 upwards.
- Eight white Lanterns with LED candles.
- Museum available for ceremony at a suitable time between 12.30pm and 3.30pm.

ON THE LEGAL SIDE

Every couple getting married in Ireland, are required to serve a minimum of 3 months notice to the Irish State of their intention to marry, this is regardless of what kind of ceremony they choose to have. To serve your notice to the State, a couple must arrange an appointment with a Registrar to present their required documentation.
